FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is Believe & Achieve?

Much more than just an afterschool program, Believe & Achieve helps students discover their skills and become passionate about using their talents in life. All this is done in the context of meaningful relationships and a fun environment.

What do we do?

We place a strong emphasis on academic success, requiring students to finish their homework, work on their reading and math skills, and complete educational projects as assigned by our classroom leaders. Our classrooms are fun, innovative and creative work areas where children learn respect and get excited about learning. In addition to time in the classroom, students spend their time rotating through a variety of activities that include athletics, music, drama, free play, computer lab, library, Bible study and worship, and art. All activities are supervised by caring and mentoring adults. An after-school snack and a well-balanced dinner meal are provided each day.

What is the cost?

We are pleased to offer this program for FREE to all students in grades 1 through 8, but *registration is required.*

How do I register my children?

What are the hours?

Students arrive immediately after school and are invited to stay until 8:00 p.m. Those not desiring to stay for the evening portion of our program can be picked up in the lower parking lot before dinner at 5:45 p.m.

Is transportation provided from school?

Yes! Please make arrangements at school for your child to ride the school bus to Wade. Virginia students should make arrangements with their school to ride the school bus to Bluefield College. A Wade Center van will pick them up there.

Is transportation provided at the end of after-school?

No. Due to rising fuel costs transportation home will not be provided this year. Please make every effort to make arrangements for your child's timely departure. We do not have staff beyond 8:00 p.m. Students who are not picked up on time will be taken to the Bluefield Police Department to await your arrival. Special transportation arrangements can be made by contacting Vicki Mahood. If you would be willing to help a child get home by car pooling please let Vicki know.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURES

Students not coming by school bus should be dropped off in the lower lot and enter the building only through the doors indicated. The lower parking lot is the safest place for them to get out of your car.

Believe & Achieve will finish PROMPTLY at **8:00 p.m.** Monday through Thursday. Transportation must be arranged so that your children can be picked up on time in the lower parking lot. We will not have staff available to watch your child past the daily dismissal time. It is unsafe for students to be in the playground unsupervised. Children left past the dismissal time will be escorted to the Bluefield Police Department.
